**Under the agreement for 2015
Mount Archer State School will receive**

*Estimated on 2014 data. Actual funding will be determined after 2015 enrolment data is finalised.

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students above the National Minimum Standard in NAPLAN Reading for 2015 by 2%. (Year 3 from 93% to 95%, Year 5 from 92% to 94%).
- Increase the percentage of students above the National Minimum Standard in NAPLAN Writing for 2015 by 2%. (Year 3 from 96% to 98%, Year 5 from 89% to 91%).
- Increase the percentage of students above the National Minimum Standard in NAPLAN Numeracy for 2015 by 2%. (Year 3 from 97% to 99%, Year 5 from 94% to 96%).
- Increase student achievement in Year 1, 2 and 3 PAT Reading and Mathematics from February to October 2015 by an effect size greater than 0.6.
- Increase student achievement in Year 4, 5, 6 and 7 PAT Reading and Mathematics from February to October 2015 by an effect size greater than 0.4.
- Provide Individual Learning Guarantees for 100% of students not achieving at National Minimum Standards in Literacy and Numeracy.

Our strategy will be to

- Continue professional development to consolidate use of explicit instruction, High Reliability Literacy Teaching Procedures (John Munro) and Feedback (Hattie) as teaching methods for improved student achievement supported by Master Teacher.
- Identify and provide professional development opportunities for staff to improve the teaching of writing.
- Continue school-wide standardised assessment, moderation and analysis in numeracy and writing to monitor student progress.
- Provide additional support during mathematics lessons every day in all classes from prep to year 3.
- Embed Individual Learning Guarantees for students below National Minimum Standards in literacy and numeracy.
- Continue research based oral language program and collect data to monitor student progress.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Employ teacher aides for numeracy – 1 hour daily in every class from Prep to Year 3.	\$105 785
• Providing professional development focused on literacy and numeracy to consolidate Explicit Instruction, teaching of reading and writing.	\$15 000
• Employ registered teacher to provide Oral Language program Prep to Year 1.	\$40 823
• Employ a registered teacher to provide literacy programs for Year 1 and 2 students identified as potentially below national minimum standard.	\$80 810
