This funding will be used to

- Achieve A-C results for English of 85% or greater for all year levels.
- Deliver oral language intervention for all Prep and Year 1 students
- Achieve 65% of students at or above Literacy Continuum age equivalent marker in Prep, Year 1 and Year 2 for all domain areas.

Our initiatives include

- Accessing The Reading Centre professional development and resources to develop a deep understanding of unit planning, that aligns the Australian Curriculum and Literacy Continuum.
- Review the whole school pedagogical framework, outlining key pedagogy for consistency of classroom practice.
- Engage with Visible Learning (Corwin) professional development activities to unpack and upskill teachers on deep classroom discussions and collaborative learning.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Employing a speech pathologist (0.8FTE) to assess all Prep/Year 1 students and deliver professional development and training to staff around high impact early years practice. | \$66 000 |
| • Purchasing additional Teacher aides to support targeted literacy interventions | \$157 091 |
| • Funding of a Deputy Principal position to enhance consistency of curriculum and pedagogy delivery. | \$63 000 |
| • Funding of a full time Local Relief Teacher to provide curriculum release time. | \$75 000 |
| • Funding curriculum planning release time for teachers to unpack the demands of assessment tasks | \$50 000 |
| • Funding professional development and collaborative learning activities (Corwin) to drive consistency of pedagogy and curriculum delivery. | \$22 000 |
